2022 Angel T Black Pot Cook Off Rules & Regulations

- Team entry fee is \$60. This includes 2 complimentary tickets to the event. Additional team members must pay the event admission fee of \$10/person.
- Teams can register and begin setting up anytime between 7am-10am.
- You may begin cooking no earlier than 8am.
- Meat must be raw at check-in, but it can be pre-seasoned.
- We WILL supply serving bowls, utensils, and napkins.
- You must supply your own ingredients, rice, cooking utensils, tables, portable burners for cooking, etc.
- Only small QUIET generators are allowed. Absolutely NO loud generators.
- We recommend that each team cooks 60-80 servings.
- We will NOT provide rice this year. There are outlets throughout the arena that you can use, but we CANNOT guarantee electricity by your spot. Precooked rice may be brought in.
- Cooking spots will be around 12ft x 14ft. You may bring a tent if necessary for your décor, but it is not recommended, as we will be in a covered arena.
- Teams must keep areas clean during event and are responsible for cleaning their own cooking areas at end of event.
- We will have trash cans placed throughout the event. Feel free to being your own trashcan for your cooking spot.
- We ask that each team brings at least ONE auction item to enter into our auction. This is not required, but greatly appreciated. If you would like ideas, please message us and we will send you our current wish list.
- Cook team spots WILL BE LIMITED this year, so we ask that you register as early as possible, using the form on the previous page. Please MAIL a CHECK or money order PRIOR to the event.
- Cook Team Entry Fee paid the DAY OF will increase to \$80 at the door.

AWARDS

- **Judges Award** We will have a panel of judges with many different tasting backgrounds. They will rate each dish on a scale from 1-10. We will give out a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place award for this category. Ties are possible.
- Fan Fav Award Everyone will be given one ticket at gate entry. They will be asked to place that ticket in a jar of their favorite dish's table. We will give out one award only for this category.
- **Best Dressed Award** Get creative with your cook team's costumes and table display! Plan to decorate for a spot that is around 12ft x 14ft. If you plan to use any kind of back drop taller than 4ft, please call us prior to the event!! Tents are allowed for décor purposes, but not necessary (we will all be in the covered arena). Anonymous judges will be judging this throughout the event. We will give out one award only for this category.
